

Westown TID - Background

- Project Area
 - 4.5 square miles
 - 8 roadway segments covering 8 miles
 - 24 intersections in total
 - 9 signalized intersections
 - 3 roundabouts
- 2030 Horizon Year
 - 22 committed developments
 - Additional roadway connections
 - LOS D Service Standard



Westown TID – Middletown Warwick-North Broad St Connector



- Redevelopment of Johnson Controls property
- 2 roadway alignments considered
 - Option 1 Ash Boulevard Connector
 - Ash Boulevard to Middletown Square Entrance
 - Option 2- Greenlawn Boulevard Connector
 - Greenlawn Boulevard to Popeye's Driveway

Westown TID – Middletown Warwick-North Broad St Connector

- Features of Option 1:
 - Shorter roadway section
 - Avoids RR geometric challenges present with Option 2
 - Estimated Cost = \$5.8 million
- Features of Option 2:
 - RR geometric challenges (curvature and superelevation)
 - May provide more desirable access for the Johnson Controls property
 - Estimated Cost= \$7.8 million








Westown TID – Middletown Warwick-North Broad St Connector


- Either alignment allows for:
 - Elimination of widening along Middletown Warwick Rd
 - Elimination of one RR crossing (NB SR 71 left turns and NB Middletown Warwick Rd right turns) and partial removal of traffic signal
 - Relieves pressure at Cedar Lane Rd & SR 71
- Add to Eastown TID Improvements via amended agreement


Total Costs

LOS E = \$40.5 million


Westown TID – SR 71 & St Annes Church Road (Long-term)

- Long-Term Alternatives:
 - Single Lane Roundabout
 - Traffic Signal w/ separate turn lanes along all approaches
- Roundabout is preferred option:
 - Safety benefits
 - Traffic calming
- Roundabout design being investigated;
 Expected Construction Schedule =
 Approx. 2030




Westown TID – SR 71 & St Annes Church Road (Interim)

Due to existing safety concerns, interim alternatives being considered. Either option would maintain existing intersection geometry and remove bypass lane along NB SR 71.



- Quick implementation
- Congestion expected during peak hours (no congestion expected during off-peak hours)



- Estimated 2-3 years to implement from start of design
- Congestion not expected with this option
- Due to greater cost of signal, could delay or eliminate the roundabout alternative in the future
