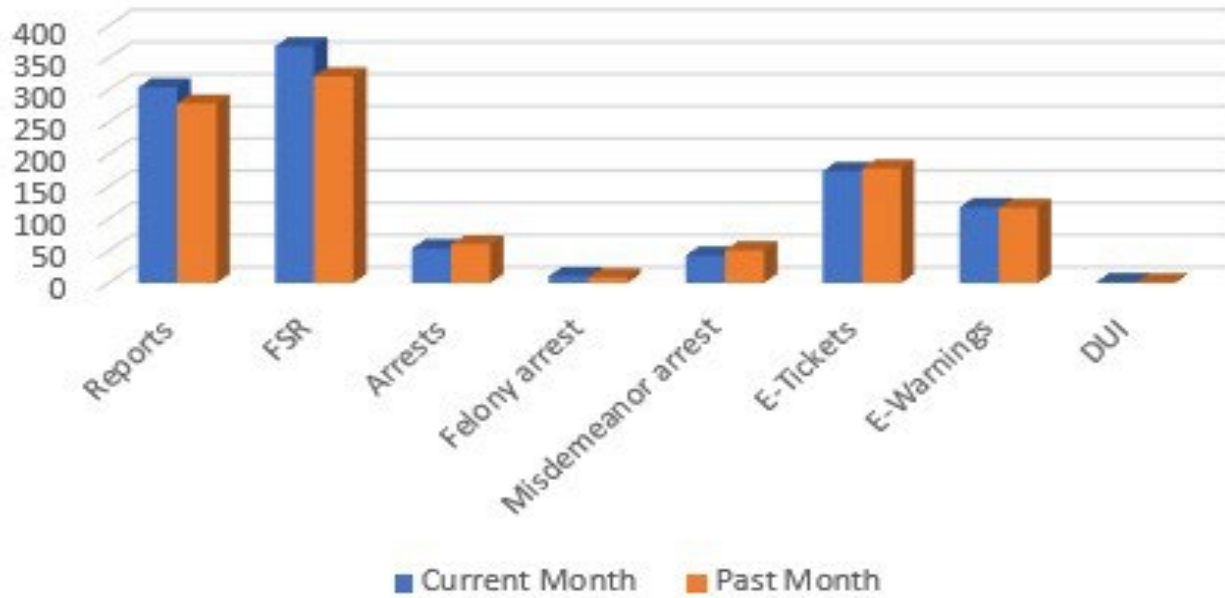
Motor Vehicle Theft

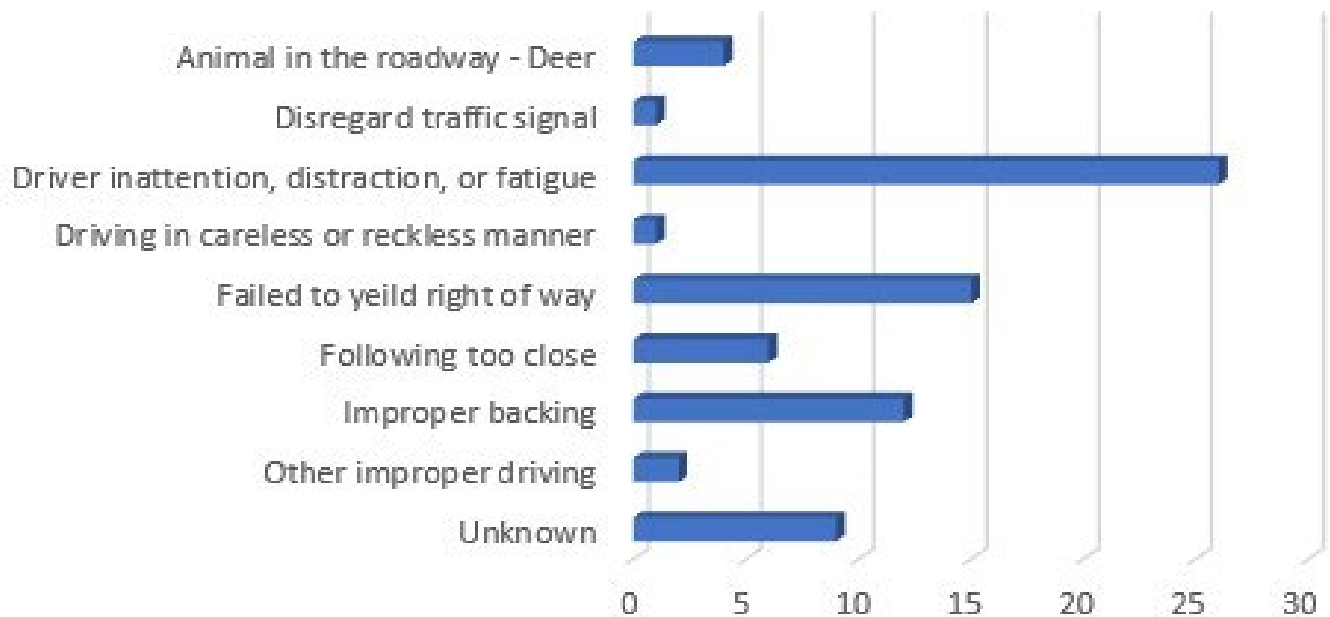

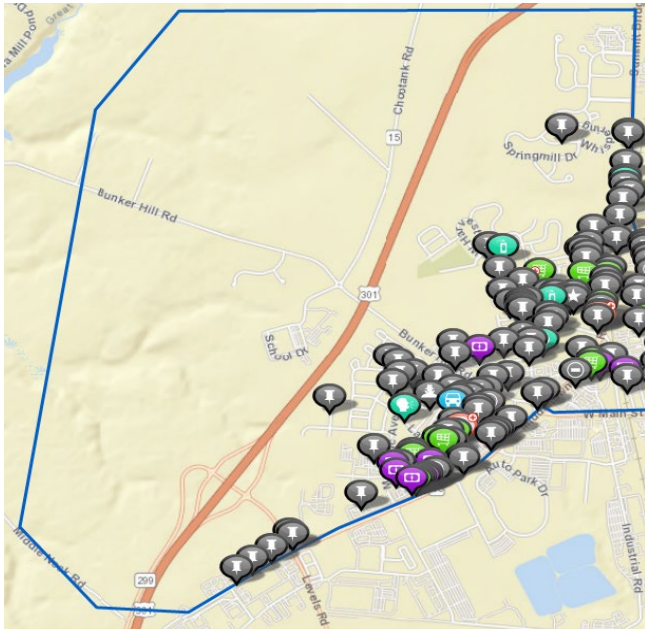

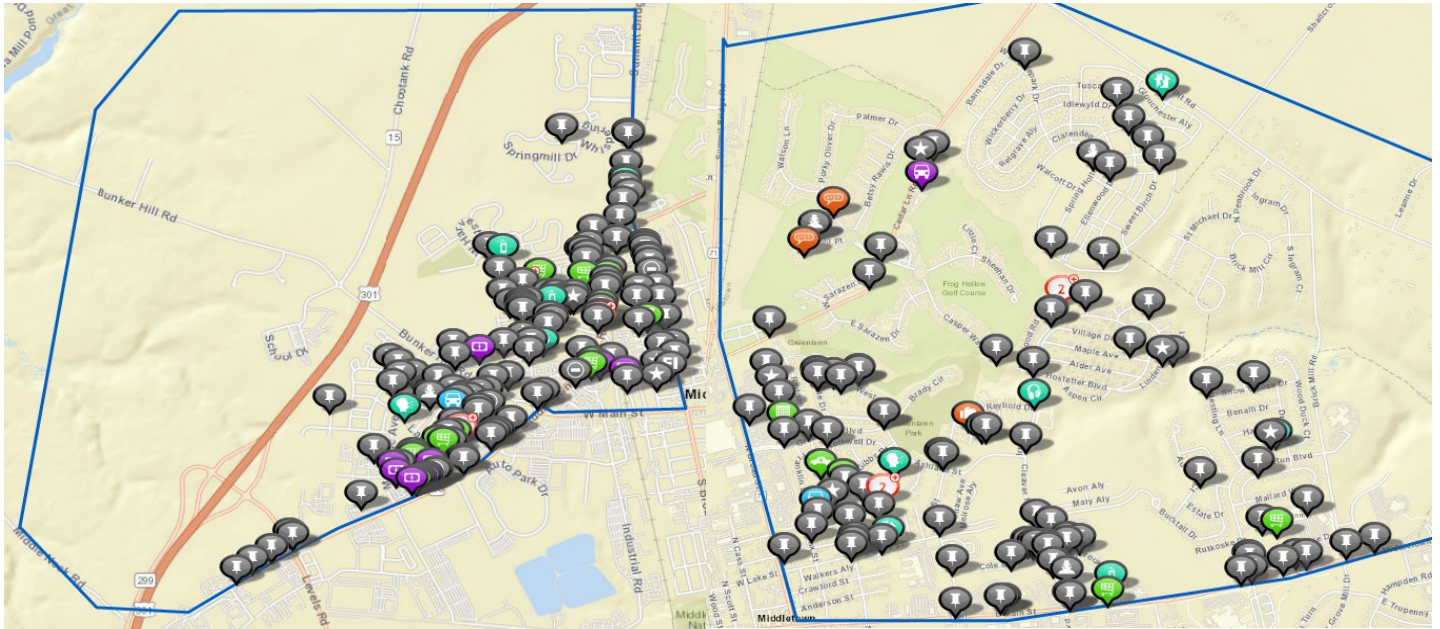

Documented Incidents-169



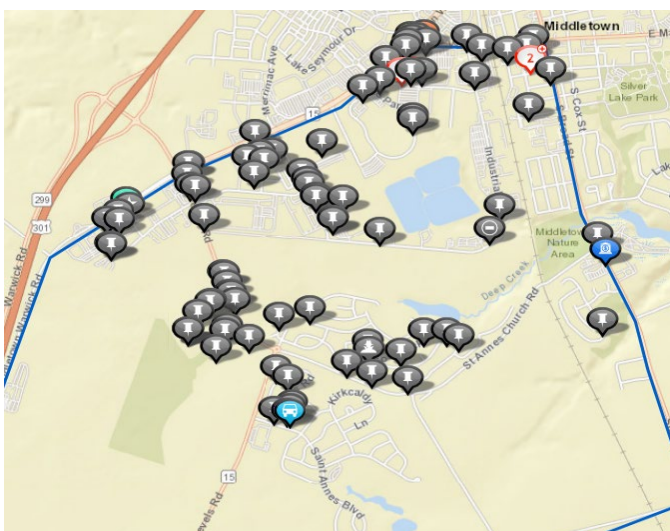

Documented Incidents-122



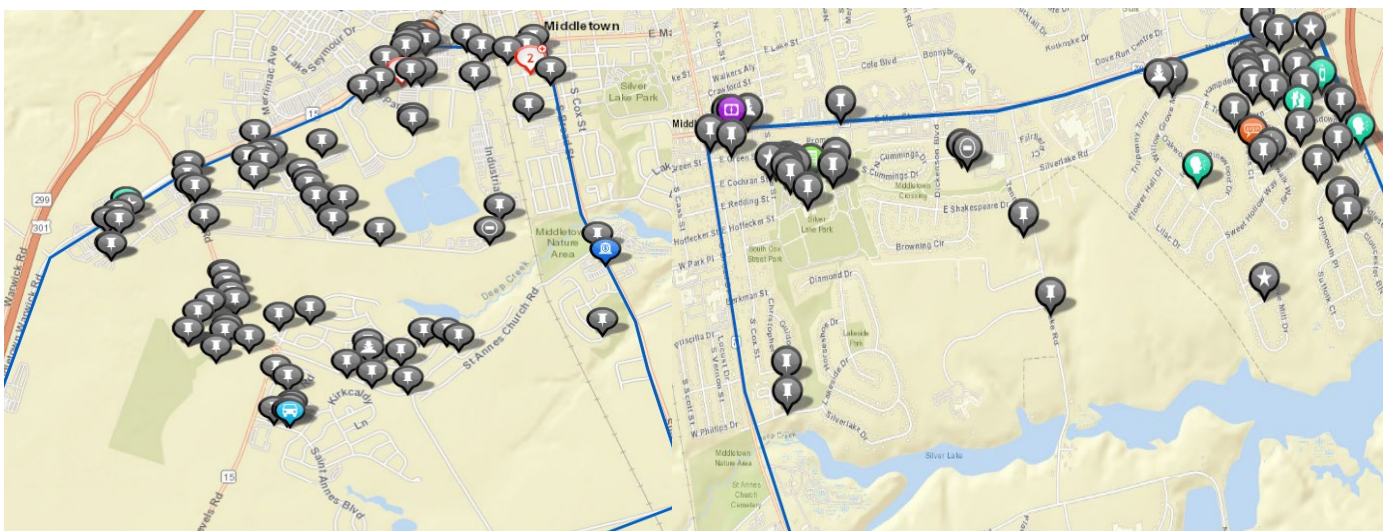
