Robbery 2nd

Food Lion

On Sunday February 22nd @ 3:00 pm, Officers responded to the Food Lion reference a subject who engaged in a physical altercation with an employee. The subject, identified as **James Womer, male 29**, assaulted the employee as he was fleeing the store with unpaid grocery items. Womer was taken into custody and charged with Robbery 2nd and committed in lieu of \$2,200.00 bail.

Burglary 3rd - Attempt

Finest Vape & Smoke Shop

Smoke King Smoke Shop

On Wednesday February 25th @ 11:00 pm, Officers responded to the Finest Vape & Smoke Shop regarding two subjects attempting to forcibly enter the business. The subjects were using a rubber mallet to gain entry via the front door. The subjects were apprehended and identified as two teenagers, ages 15 and 17. The investigation also revealed that the same subjects attempted to gain entry into the Smoke King Smoke Shop earlier in the night. The subjects were charged with Burglary 3rd and related offenses and released on unsecured bail.

Burglary 3rd

Target – parking lot

On Saturday February 28th @ 3:00 pm, Officers responded to the Target parking lot regarding a Theft in progress. The investigation revealed that the victim agreed to meet the suspect, later identified as **Nasiym Blackwell**, male 18 to sell four wristwatches. As the victim met with Blackwell, a second unknown suspect grabbed the watches from the victim's vehicle. Both suspects fled from the scene, however Blackwell was apprehended. The watches have not been recovered. Blackwell was arrested for Burglary 3rd and related offenses and released on \$7,000.00 unsecured bail.

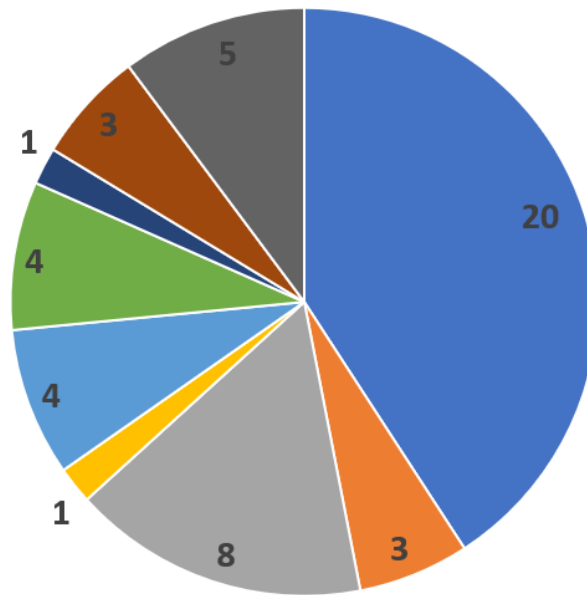
