 - B. Motion to approve a Public Assembly Permit request for Middletown Main Street to utilize Cochran Square on Sept. 26 for pop-up vendors during "Girls' Day Out."
 - C. 410 Diamond State Blvd., Suite D – Conditional Use Permit request for a small-batch light manufacturing and assembly of candles, room sprays and other home fragrance products, including wax melting and pouring, product assembly, labeling, packaging, storage, e-commerce order fulfillment and office work (Melt Your Heart LLC) in an M-I zoned area. CU-16-26. Tax Parcel No. 23-008.00-115.
 - D. 20 N. Cox Street and 32 Anderson Street – Preliminary Minor Subdivision Plan for the adjustment of the common lot line between the two parcels listed, for the construction of a single-family semi-detached building in an R-2 and C-2 zoned area. Tax Parcel Nos: 23-006.00-239 and 23-006.00-241.
 - E. 1924 Middle Neck Road – 301 Business Park South – Amended Record Major Land Development Plan for a 1.9 million +/- square foot, two-story e-commerce fulfillment center, along with associated parking, loading area and accessways. These plans will supersede the Recorded Plan dated Oct. 21, 2025. Tax Parcel No. 23-068.00-002.
 - F. 102 N. Catherine Street – Preliminary Subdivision Plan for the division of one parcel into two additional residential lots to have frontage along Crawford Street in an R-2 zoned area. Tax Parcel No. 23-006.00-185.

- G. 224 Wiggins Mill Road – Preliminary Major Subdivision Plan for Greenough at the Estates of Saint Annes, proposing 33 new single-family detached lots on two streets. The property was designated Lot 1 of the Estates at Saint Annes Major Subdivision Plan, recorded under instrument number 20031003-0128103.

- H. 255 Celebration Court (Parcel E-4 Levels Business Park) – Record Major Land Development Plan for a four-story, 50,920 square foot hotel building (Summerton Suites), with associated improvements, in a C-3 zoned area.
Tax Parcel No. 23-065.00-017.
- I. 765 Middletown-Warwick Road – Major Land Development Plan for Phase 3 of the Westown Town Center Parcel 3, to amend the Record Plan approved in 2018. This plan proposes 100,614-square-feet of building area within Buildings B, C, D, and F. Building E, depicted on the original plan as a credit union, has been removed. Buildings G, H, and I have been constructed. Tax Parcel No. 23-049.00-038.
- J. 101 Sandhill Drive – Record Major Land Development Plan for a 7,320 +/- square-foot Discount Tire store in a C-3 zoned area. Tax Parcel No. 23-005.00-315.
